MONDAY, APRIL 12TH

- Depart the US for overnight flights to London Heathrow (LHR)

TUESDAY, APRIL 13TH – STONEHENGE / BATH / BRISTOL

- Morning arrival into Heathrow
- Welcome by our CCT Staff and local guides
- Depart for Stonehenge
- Tour of Stonehenge
- Depart for Bath with an optional visit to the Roman Baths (additional cost)
- Depart for Bristol hotel for check-in
- Welcome Dinner at hotel (included)
- Orientation and opening devotional / hymn sing

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 14TH – BRISTOL

- Breakfast at hotel
- Depart for The New Room, the oldest Methodist building in the world and one of the great landmarks of evangelical history, where we discover how preaching, hymn singing, and spiritual awakening transformed England during the 18th Century
- Lunch at a local restaurant (included)
- Depart for the sites of George Müller, tracing his orphan ministry through the years and hearing the inspiring story of answered prayer and unwavering trust in God's provision
- Depart for hotel
- Dinner on your own
- Evening free

THURSDAY, APRIL 15TH – COTSWOLDS / GLOUCESTER / BRISTOL

- Breakfast at hotel
- Depart for Hanham Mount, a World Methodist Heritage Site where John Wesley preached his first open-air sermon to the Kingswood coal miners in April 1739
- Depart for the Cotswolds countryside, stopping in Cirencester, birthplace of Mary Peters, who, in the 19th Century, wrote over 50 hymns including *Through the Love of God our Saviour*
- Some additional places to visit and sights to see include St. John Baptist Church (known as the Cathedral of the Cotswolds and one of the largest churches in England), a well-preserved Roman amphitheater, and the grounds of Austine St. Mary's Abbey.
- Lunch at a local restaurant or possibly afternoon tea (included)
- Depart for Gloucester, a city heavily influenced by English hymnody
- Attend an evensong service at Gloucester Cathedral, known for serving as the training ground for major church music icons and is the namesake of several classic hymn tunes used across the world
- Depart for hotel
- Dinner at hotel (included)

FRIDAY, APRIL 16TH – OXFORD / BLETCHLEY PARK / MILTON KEYNES

- Breakfast and check-out of hotel
- Depart for Oxford, one of the world's most celebrated university cities and a center of English Christian scholarship for centuries
- Visit Martyr's Memorial, remembering the courage and sacrifice of the English Reformers whose faith helped shape the future of the church
- Lunch on your own
- Depart for Bletchley Park, known as the principal code breaking center during WWII as well the birthplace of modern computing
- Depart for Milton Keynes hotel for check-in
- Dinner at hotel (included)



SATURDAY, APRIL 17TH – OLNEY / LUTTERWORTH

- Breakfast at hotel
- Depart for Olney
- Visit the Cowper & Newton Museum, St. Peter and St. Paul Church, hearing the stories behind *Amazing Grace*, *God Moves in a Mysterious Way* and *There Is a Fountain Filled with Blood*
- Lunch at a local restaurant (included)
- Depart for Lutterworth, where John Wycliffe helped lay the foundations for the English Bible movement
- Visit St. Mary's church, where we will explore the story of Scripture in the language of ordinary people and the spiritual roots that shaped England's later revival movements
- Depart for hotel
- Dinner on your own
- Evening free



SUNDAY, APRIL 18TH – BEDFORD / CAMBRIDGE / LONDON

- Breakfast and check-out of hotel
- Depart for Bedford, home of *Pilgrim's Progress* author, John Bunyan
- Visit the Bunyan Meeting House & Museum, where we will trace the story of Bunyan's imprisonment, preaching ministry, and enduring influence on Christian literature
- Depart for Cambridge, a place where iconic hymns were composed as well as the academic home to prolific hymn writers such as Isaac Watts, Ralph Vaughan Williams and George Herbert
- Possible evensong service at Kings College Chapel
- Depart for London
- Check-in to hotel in London
- Dinner at hotel (included)
- Evening free



MONDAY, APRIL 19TH – LONDON

- Breakfast at hotel
- Depart for Wesley's Chapel, the Museum of Methodism and John Wesley's House
- Visit Bunhill Fields Burial Ground, the final resting place of John Bunyan, William Blake and Isaac Watts
- Depart for the Southbank area of London
- Lunch at a local restaurant (included)
- Possible visit to the Church of England's national archive at the nearby Lambeth Palace Library which houses many important gospels, bibles and prayer books
- Continue to Covent Garden and/or Leicester Square for guided sightseeing
- Possible evensong service at Westminster Abbey
- Dinner on your own
- Depart for hotel



TUESDAY, APRIL 20TH – BRIGHTON / CHARTWELL / LONDON

- Breakfast at hotel
- Depart for Brighton to trace the history and impact of Ms. Charlotte Elliot and her hymn contributions such as *Just As I Am*
- Visit the Lanes, a quaint and compact shopping area boasting many independent shops, art galleries and jewelry shops
- Lunch at a local restaurant (included)
- Depart for Chartwell, the former home of Winston Churchill, now preserved as a living museum
- Depart for hotel
- Dinner on your own
- Evening free



WEDNESDAY, APRIL 21ST – LONDON

- Breakfast at hotel
- Depart for Buckingham Palace to witness the Changing of the Guard
- Continue to the City of London for a self-guided tour of St. Paul's Cathedral, exploring the Cathedral Floor, Crypt and Dome Galleries
- Lunch on your own
- Depart for the Tower of London to see the Beefeaters, ravens and the Crown Jewels
- Depart for Farewell dinner with closing devotion / hymn sing
- Depart for hotel
